OVERVIEW

The Colorado College Men's Soccer Team will be continuing its tradition of international travel this summer when the team visits Brazil to train and play at the facilities of some of the top professional teams in the world.

Colorado College Soccer alumni, parents, and friends are invited to join us for the first week of the trip in beautiful Salvador, Bahia.

The group will stay at the same hotel as the players, which is on the beach, and will be able to watch the CC players train with the Brazilian club E.C. Vittoria. Vittoria is a first division professional club based in Salvador with a beautiful training facility at their stadium, which is 15 minutes from the hotel. The team will train twice a day and will have ample time in the afternoons and evenings to spend on the beach and visiting the many tourist attractions that Salvador has to offer. The group will be able to watch CC play 2-3 matches against local teams, which will provide a great test for CC against skilled Brazilian opposition. There will be excursions planned every day to local artist's studios, 16th century colonial city centers, and other local attractions. The trip will be a wonderful experience both in being able to spend time with CC team, watching them play, and getting to experience one of the most exciting cities in Brazil.



There will also be a community service project as part of our foundation: The Favela Project. The Favela project is a not for profit organization that is dedicated to using the game of soccer to help improve the lives of some of the poorest Brazilian children. The group will host soccer clinics and will give away apparel, equipment, and other items to some of the poorest kids in Brazil.
